What is the Chiari1000?



The *Chiari1000* was launched in September 2015 as a groundbreaking research project whose aim was to use the web to create a consistent dataset on a large, diverse population of at least 1,000 Chiari patients. Participants answered self-report surveys, complete validated, neuropsychological scales, and share their medical imaging (MRIs, CTs, etc.). In addition, some participants provided biological samples and participate in additional studies.
